The main export crop is copra, the dried white flesh of the nut. It takes months for this raw material to reach the industrial processing plants in Europe or Asia. By then the copra is very dirty and rancid so that when the oil is extracted it must be chemically refined, bleached and deodorised (RBD).

Managing Virgin Coconut Oil

DME Extra Virgin Coconut Oil is a clear or slightly cloudy liquid at temperatures above 26°C. As it cools it forms white 'pearls' and starts to solidify. Below 22°C it is a snow white solid. If the oil is solid, place the container in warm water to melt it, or simply scoop it out.
